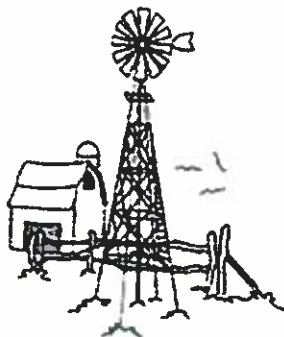


Millersburg Town Council Meeting July 22, 2020

A motion was made by Jim Winkler to approve the minutes for Wednesday, July 8, 2020. The motion was seconded by Dean Smith and upon a voice vote was approved unanimously.

I. Water Superintendent

- The sprinkler splash day at Cook Station has been a huge success. Ben would like to continue doing this on Wednesday's whenever it's nice out. Frisbee golf has also been getting really popular at Cook Station.

II. Waste Water Superintendent

- Ben is in need of a new trash pump. The trash pump is very old and it's been here since Ben started working here. Ben presented pictures of two different trash pumps and the costs to the Council. Ben, Jim, and Dean all agreed on the larger 2 inch pump that cost \$849.00.

III. Community Development

- Farmer's Day has been cancelled. There will be a discussion with Floyd to see if the car show is still a go for Friday August 21st.
- Charles Beard is still working with Ben on the historic grant.

IV. Maintenance Director

- Due to losing the Cross Roads grant, the Town itself will cover the expenses to fix the designated roads.
- When the roads are in the works, Jim would like MacKenzie to type a formal letter, have the Council sign it, and give this to Forest River. Within the letter it will contain information about transport drivers, trucks, and other haulers that pass along that road to help keep families, children, and properties protected and safe. If Forest River doesn't comply then we may have to ticket their trucks.

V. Marshal

- Alan is recovering well after his knee surgery.

VI. Park

- Ben would like to purchase a new trash can to place at Eagle Park. It would cost a little over \$500.00, the same as the Cook Station trash cans. This would help enhance the look of the park. Jim and Dean gave Ben permission to purchase the trash can. –Ben will also be getting a new sign and score board for the diamonds at Cook Station. Jim expressed how well the park and park board are doing really well this year. –The basketball poles have still not been put in. If Brian doesn't get them put in by the end of the week, then Ben and Zack will do them.

IX. New Business


No New Business.
